



OUTSTANDING STUDENT AWARD

Purpose: To recognize students enrolled in Allied Health Programs whose achievements are judged to be outstanding.

Guidelines:

1. The nominee must have been an enrolled student during May 31, 2007 through June 1, 2008 in a program of the same category as his/her nomination.
2. The student body with faculty supervision should select the student.
3. In the selection of the student for an award, the following areas should be considered:
 - a) Academic Record
 - b) Extracurricular school or profession-related activities
 - c) Attendance
 - d) Cooperation and conduct
 - e) Initiative
 - f) Ability to get along with people
4. If your school has an accredited program in more than one category, you may nominate one student from each category (DA, MA, MAA, MLT, MT, OLT, PT).
5. A special nomination form must be used.
6. Remember to attach the student's statement on "**How Will AMT Certification Help to Further My Career**".
7. Nominations must be postmarked on or before April 1, 2008 to be accepted.

Winning Applicants:

1. The Outstanding Student Award recipient will receive a \$250 monetary prize and plaque.
2. The check and plaque will be sent directly to the student or to the school for formal presentation if requested.
3. The school of each Outstanding Student Award recipient will receive a specially prepared plaque for display. (see note below)
4. Every winner will receive a personal letter of commendation from AMT commemorating the occasion.

NOTE: If the student attends the AMT National Convention in Providence, Rhode Island, July 7-12, 2008 their meeting registration fee will be complimentary and the student will be recognized at the AMT Awards Banquet.
